1. Multiple Choice Questions: (05)

- i. Which of the following face shape is said to be perfect?
 - a. round
 - b. diamond
 - c. oval

- ii. In order to give an effect of length to a round - shaped face, apply shader over the...
 - a. cheeks and forehead
 - b. angles of jaw and temple areas
 - c. chin and forehead

- iii. How can you best apply corrective make-up for round eyes?
 - a. by applying dark shades to the inner and light to the outer eyelids
 - b. by applying dark shades to the outer eyelid, and highlighting under the brow
 - c. by applying light matt eye shadow

- iv. How would you apply the corrective make - up for close - set eyes?
